Hiltscher Park: A dirt, tree shaded, path of about 3.25 miles through rustic Hiltscher Park is the allure of this walk. After less than 3/4ths of a mile of very gradual rise in elevation, we'll follow a trail that takes us past horse property residences. The trail is wide and (leashed) dog friendly. Because the trail is unpaved, recent rains can make it muddy and/or slippery. Proper footgear is suggested. We'll pass oaks, willows and sycamores while bordering a streambed. Was one of you New Year's resolutions to exercise more? Start off the New Year right! Bring a picnic lunch to enjoy. A hat, sunscreen and water are suggested.

Meet in the OASIS overflow parking lot at 5th and Marguerite at 11:00am *sharp* to carpool. In case of rain or temperatures above 90 degrees, the walk will be canceled.
